Julie and team will continue their investigation and develop a recommendation for the Capital Reserves committee for inclusion in the 2020 Capital Plan.

V-C sales has been onsite doing preliminary inspections of all gutters and downspouts. Several co-owners have complained of massive dripping over their entrance door.

The asphalt work on 2820, 2822, 2831 should commence later this month.

Curb replacement needs to be a priority in 2020. Pam Fetke will be providing information to the Capital Reserves committee.

New Business:

3098 Riverview Lane requested approval to install an additional outdoor electrical outlet on their patio at the co-owner's expense. Work will be done by a licensed electrician. The request was approved. If there are other co-owners interested in adding similar outlets, please contact the Property Manager for procedure and board approval.
